
# Operating Instructions – Washer Dryer Whirlpool AWG329 1100

# Control Panel



- A. Programme selector knob
- B. Temperature knob
- C. Spin RPM selection dial
- D. Additional rinse intensive rinse push button
- E. Economy programme Energy save push button
- F. ON/OFF push button
- G. Automatic detergent dispenser
- H. Programme pointer
- I. Temperature index
- J. Operating indicator light
- K. Drying time knob

# Programme selector knob:

Allows the wash programme to be chosen by turning the knob clockwise until the marker on the control panel aligns with the desired programme.

# Temperature knob:

This is needed to choose washing temperatures from 30°C to 90°C.

#### Spin RPM Selection knob:

This is used to select the final spin, stopping with a full tub, or only draining off the water. To automatically end washing programmes with the spin, position the dial pointer on the desired speed.

# Washing powder distributor:

The removable drawer to the left of the control panel. The dispenser is formed by three compartments with numbers «1» and «2» being for pre wash and detergent respectively.

# Drying time knob:

This is used to choose the drying time up to a maximum of 120 minutes. Turn the knob clockwise to select the desired time.

#### Using the Machine

- Prepare the laundry.
- Door opening the machine has been fitted with a safety device that prevents the door for opening while a program is in operation. To open the door, turn the temperature start/stop dial onto its 0 position and wait for 1-2 minutes to allow the safety device to disconnect.
- Load the laundry.
- Add detergent and fabric softener if required.
- Turn the programme selector dial clockwise until the desired programme is aligned with the programme pointer.
- Select any additional wash features by pressing the desired buttons, i.e. energy save button.
- Start the machine.

#### To dry

- Turn temperature selector knob onto position 0.
- Select the time by turning the drying time knob.
- Turn the programme dial to coincide with the drying symbols \*.
- Open the water tap and turn the start, stop, and temperature dial onto the «I» symbol to begin the drying cycle.
